Dear Valued Customers,

Some great news on refrigerant pricing.

Over the past month there appears to be a global softening in the pricing of most refrigerants. With this information at hand and some forward bulk orders in place Actrol are able to reduce our list price commencing 1 June, 2011.

The reductions are significant.

R134a	Down	6%
R404A	Down	10%
R507	Down	10%
R410A	Down	20%

Whilst the pricing looks better in the short term it is important to understand that the major contributing factors which initiate these increases have not been fully resolved. This therefore leads to continued instability in the market place and we continue to advise that you take this into consideration when quoting future work.

Please note that price increases for HCFC's like R22 are independent to the above and predominately related to import and manufacturing quotas. These continue to steadily increase in cost on a quarterly basis the next increase due in June, 2011.

Actrol continue to work hard to ensure a constant supply of quality refrigerant and endeavour to keep our customers informed of any changes in the global and local markets.
