It has been well reported that the prices for refrigerants will continue to rise throughout the year.

The month of May will see another increase with Actrol's list price increasing as follows:

R134a	5%
R404A	10%
R507	10%

These price hikes are happening globally and are well beyond our control. At best we can only advise where they are heading.

In addition to refrigerant, we are also well aware of significant changes in raw material costs for copper, steel and aluminium. The cover story in the March edition of JARN* highlights this fact and forewarns potential for cost increase in finished product, as well as key componentry.
