# Everson's Food Processing Plant

## Background—

In the town of Frederickton, NSW a food processing facility by the name of Everson's was experiencing ongoing issues with their refrigeration plant. The equipment was old and breakdowns lead to loss of stock, time, and significant financial outlay to repair and have the facility back up and running. The systems were highly inefficient and even when running smoothly would cost the owner excess in electricity.

## Solution—

The changeover from old to new equipment was conducted while the site continued to operate. This limited disruption to the entire plant and ensured they could continue to conduct business and maintain employment levels. The use of multiple DC-3 systems across the plant ensured, if there ever was a breakdown or refrigerant leak, the issue would be isolated and refrigerant would only be lost in a small section of the plant, minimising general disruption and the potential asset loss. Everson's expressed the importance of having no disruption to their production schedule and therefore the DC-3 system was proposed for the job.

## Reflect—

The supply of DC-3 to power the facility will not only assure the customer their facility will run smoothly; it also means they will see significant cost and time savings. The DC-3 is compatible with live system monitoring capabilities which means if there is ever an issue the installer will be notified immediately and can fault find sooner rather than later.
